Grant Proposal Application Required Documents + New Application Questions



Required Documents

- Completed Application
- Completed Project Budget on provided template Secured/pending income
- Current Organizational Operation Budget
- Completed W-9 (Rev. October 2018)
 - Mailing address for payment
 - \bigcirc
 - Found on IRS website: https://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/fw9.pdf
- Current IRS Tax Ruling Letter (Government agencies/public schools exempt)
- Current Audited Financial Statements
- Current 990 Form



Total project/program amount & total amount requested from San Manuel

All organizations must submit form including government agencies and public schools

Required Documents - Continued

- Confirmation of Support
 - Actual copy of check, approval letters, etc.
 - o Confirmation must be within the program year
- For Schools, Tribal & City Governments: Signed Letter from Principal/Tribal Chair/City Manger
- Quote/Bid for purchase of a specific item



New Application Questions

- How are the demographics of the community/clients your organization serves reflected in the composition of your staff, board, and/or volunteers?
- Provide general ethnicity information of staff and volunteers drop down menu
- Provide a brief description of your Board of Directors 3.
- Select the Giving Pillar your request falls under & explain how it relates to your selected pillar 4. What are some of the strengths of the community your organization is serving? How do these 5.
- strengths impact your programming?
- 6. Yes/No questions on organization's grievance policy and reasonable accommodations for individuals with a disability
- Optional Attachment: Any document related to the program that supports your request /.



Modified Questions

Original Questions

1. Projected number served.

2. What are the plans for evaluating the impact and success of the proposed activity? Indicate what process and/or impact information will be collected to measure and demonstrate success.



Updated Questions

- Overall projected number served by project or program & projected number served with grant funds.
- 2. What methods will you use to evaluate the proposed activity? What information will be collected? How will the evaluation results be used to strengthen future programming?



Modified Questions Continued


Original Questions

- Describe the long term strategy for funding this project or program.
 Include your fundraising efforts and other grants obtained or this project/program.
- Does your organization offer any volunteer opportunities that our team members can participate in?



Updated Questions

- 3. How do your organization's financial, programmatic, evaluation, and leadership strategies contribute to the sustainability of this program or project?
- 4. Does your organization offer any volunteer opportunities that our team members can participate in? If so, how do we find out about these opportunities?



Grant Proposal - Writing Tips

Problem Explains the Situation

• 5 whys, significance, & causes

Clear & Concise Writing


• Use the search feature to find overused words

Consistency is Key

• Ex: Program title on application matches budget

Provide Realistic View of Program/Organization






Problem Causes Shapes Methods


